RE: Plasco response of September 6, 2011 to PCN Elevation Request and ESR Comments

Thank you for your letter of September 6th and the responses to some of our questions.

We wish to bring to your attention that Prevent Cancer Now (PCN) has corresponded with members of your company for some time. One of the signatories of this letter, Jake Cole, a PCN Co-Chair, organized a public meeting in Ottawa on June 17, 2008, to which meeting Plasco's Rod Bryden was invited to describe the Plasco technology. The other meeting guest was Dr. Paul Connett, a renowned American chemist who advocates for Zero Waste strategies and policies.

At that time, Mr. Cole, Dr. Connett as well as Linda Gasser, our Incineration Campaign Coordinator, and a colleague asked to tour the Plasco facility, but their request was denied.


Furthermore, Linda Gasser was in touch with Mr. Richard Patten in March 2009. Please find attached a copy of an email exchange between Ms. Gasser and Mr. Patten, specifically around Plasco's claim that their technology was "not incineration". The web links remain valid and link to the Canadian Council of the Ministers of the Environment documents and the definitions of what processes they consider to be incineration.

To date, Mr. Patten has not provided the information Ms. Gasser requested in the email. Perhaps you are in a position to respond to those questions as to whether upper tier approval authorities consider the Plasco process to be incineration.


Last week we received a letter from the Ministry of the Environment dated September 6, 2011 responding to our elevation request. The Ministry indicates that Plasco may be required to provide project documentation to them relating to the concerns we raised and that they would notify us of the Director's decision.

We formally request that you add Ms. Gasser and the undersigned to your project mailing list of interested parties so that PCN could be advised of future developments.
